March 2	Begin accepting applications for admission for summer 2009 and fall 2009
March 30	Summer registration by appointment – EOPS, DSS, and Veterans – online/telephone only
March 31	Summer registration by appointment –continuing students (currently enrolled at DVC Summer 2008, fall 2008 or spring 2009) – online/telephone only
April 11 – 17	Spring break – no Saturday or Sunday classes
April 18 – 19	Saturday and Sunday classes resume after spring break
April 20	Summer registration by appointment – returning students (not enrolled at DVC in summer 2008, fall 2008 or spring 2009), new transfer students and new students excluding special admit (concurrent) students – online/telephone only
May 25	HOLIDAY – memorial day – college closed
May 26	Summer registration continues for all sessions (3-week, 6-week, and 9-week) – in-person registration begins for all students-(including special admit (concurrent) students who will be in the 11th and 12th grade during fall 2009)
May 30	Open registration for all students
June 1	Registration for classes after the session begins is on a space-available basis and will require late add code or instructor signature
June 1	3-week summer session I begins (June 1 -18)
June 1	6-week summer session I begins (June 1 – July 9)
June 1	9-week summer session I begins (June 1 – July 30)
June 18	3-week summer session I ends (June 1 -18)
June 22	3-week summer session II begins (June 22 – July 9)
June 22	6-week summer session II begins (June 22 – July 30)
July 9	3-week summer session II ends (June 22 – July 9)
July 9	6-week summer session I ends (June 1 – July 9)
July 13	3-week summer session III begins (July 13 – July 30)
July 30	3-week summer session III ends (July 13 – July 30)

Final Exams: are scheduled by the instructors and are generally held on the last day of instruction

Online/telephone registration is available daily up to midnight the day before the class section begins.

Note: Short-term course drop dates and pass/no-pass dates are calculated individually by course based on the specific number of meeting days; therefore, these dates are not included in this calendar. Add/drop, refund and pass/no-pass dates are printed on the class roster for the course. Check with the instructor.

Summer registration for classes is on a space available basis. Instructor signature or late add code required once the session begins.

Reminder: To receive a refund for a summer course, students must drop the course within 10% of the total class meetings, which in most cases, during the summer, is the first class meeting.
